### **Business News – The Annual Report – 12 Years of robust growth**

### PCS -- A Time For Growth & Change

Shareholders gave another vote of confidence to the executive team of PCS plc at the 2010 Annual General Meeting in Brighton this week. Most of the Board were returned but three directors were voted off by dissatisfied shareholders complaining about alleged incompetent handling of the current CSCS restructuring programme. The new Board expressed confidence in the future and willingness to work with four new executive directors in a constructive and amicable spirit to steer the company through the current difficult economic climate.

Mr Hugo Lanning, director of International Affairs, presented the opening report in the absence of Managing Director Marek Serwotka, who is gravely ill and currently being treated at the London Heart Hospital. A motion to convey the AGM's best wishes for a speedy recovery and return to duty was carried nem con. The Meeting endorsed the Board's decision to delegate the powers of Managing Director to Mr Lanning and the Director of Finance, Mr Christopher Baugh during Mr Serwotka's leave of absence.

Mr Lanning said he was pleased to report that PCS had delivered an **outstanding** performance in 2010 generating significantly higher profits while consuming **less** capital. Our discipline in allocating capital to the most profitable products and channels, combined with our **proactive** management of the Group's balance sheet, has allowed us to completely transform our capital position, which is now one of the **strongest** in the industry.

This, he said, is why our financial situation is objectively the best it has been for twenty years notwithstanding the collapse of the Greek economy, the slide in the value of Sterling and the Euro together with some minor concerns over the current status of the corporate pension scheme.

The Democratic Alliance asset portfolio has increased over the past financial year, but this expansion cannot be sustained without further stringent regulation and scrutiny of the performance and expenditure matrices. Left Unity Inc. trading under The Grandee brand experienced a further decline but still retains a dominant share in the human resource skills market due to slimming down its profile by outsourcing of all of the peripheral work of the PCS Democrats marque, leaving it to concentrate on its core managerial functions. The investment in the 4TM label, which was launched in 2004, is beginning to generate profit, easily offsetting the **collapse** of the Independent Left clothing franchise and the Met Police, which has gone into voluntary administration following the sudden disappearance of Mrs Yesidalli.

Mr Lanning welcomed the new members of the board which included **Mrs Frankland-Barber**, **Mr Simon Collis** and **Mr Robert Bryson** and congratulated **Mrs Diane Breen** on her re-election. Mr Bryson, who failed in an attempt to unseat Mr Serwotka last year, said that previous differences would not be a barrier to future co-operation at the highest level for the good of the company. In her acceptance speech on behalf of the new directors Mrs Breen maintained that only 4TM can bring the change our company needs. Only 4TM can offer PCS a fresh tomorrow that can roll up its **sleeves** and get on with the job.

Retiring director **Mr Charles Cochrane** was presented with a silver propelling pencil in tribute to his years of work in the pensions department and a number of other members of staff were awarded engraved Polish crystal trophies for their life-time achievements in PCS.
