PCS - *Success Through Innovation*

Shareholders gave another resounding vote of confidence to the Management team of PCS plc at the 2011 Annual General Meeting in **Brighton** this week. Most of the Board were returned but two directors were voted off by dissatisfied shareholders.

In his opening remarks, Managing Director Mark Serwotka said the new Board had renewed confidence in the future and was willing to work in a constructive and amicable spirit to steer the company through the difficult times facing the global economy today. Fears of a double-dip in Britain, flat-lining through the rest of the European Union, the effects of the tsunami in Japan, and the arrest of the head of the IMF on rape charges in New York have contributed to a volatile market. But despite some minor realignment of values which has enabled the company to release a small number of employees back to the open market the long-term outlook of PCS plc remains optimistic.

Before moving the company report there was a moment's silence for Messrs John Ellis and John McCreadie who had both sadly passed away during the previous financial year. Both men had made an outstanding contribution to the CPSA franchise over the past thirty years.

Presenting the Financial Report Mr Leon Baugh stressed that some downsizing was inevitable but the upgrade of the negotiating structures and greater productivity at Head Office has enhanced the entire range of PCS products and services. In common with all large enterprises the company had registered negative returns throughout the trading period. Generous packages were agreed for those released in line with the company ethos. Consideration will be given, in this coming year, to proposals from the shareholders for curtailing transport costs and reducing the financial burden of the AGM.

Mr Hugo Lanning, the Foreign Accounts Director, has spent a considerable amount of time and effort in promoting our products across the world including attending conferences and exhibitions in California, Wisconsin, Venezuela and the Caribbean.

Mr Nigel Pastry told the meeting that he had conducted a staff survey which showed that morale at Head Office was at unprecedented levels.

The Democratic Alliance asset **portfolio** has continued to increase over the past financial year. Left Unity Inc., trading under the *Grandee* brand, outperformed its growth targets and increased its dominant share in the human resource skills market. This helped offset continuing losses in other ventures in which PCS plc maintains a controlling interest, including PCS SWP and PCS Dems. Another subsidiary, 4TM WTF, consistently failed to meet the expectations of its investors while the Independent Left has now been put under administration on similar grounds.

Retiring regional media sales director Mr Chewbacca Devine was presented with a silver metronome, at his request, so that he could pursue his hobby in retirement. Mr Steve Comer received an engraved tankard in recognition of his loyal service and Mr Mark Hammond was awarded a collection of first edition graphic novels for his library.
