Annual Report enthusiastically endorsed at Annual General Meeting

PCS shares gained 13p on morning trading following better than expected results announced at the AGM in Brighton this week. Since 1999 the corporation has recorded significant growth year on year and this was reflected in the accounts for the last financial year.

Mr Marek Serwotka, the CEO and architect of the rapid turnaround in fortunes for PCS following the merger with two smaller mutual insurance companies in the late 1990s, was confident that PCS would continue to retain market confidence in turbulent times while defending the jobs, pay and conditions of its human resources in the personal services sector.

The soaring price of oil together with the imposition of environment controls in compliance with EU restrictions has been offset by the sale of the Victoria complex, the revaluation of Falconcrest corporate headquarters and the continuing strength of sterling in the international market. Though unit costs have risen in line with wage inflation these have been mitigated through prudent fiscal planning and utilisation of temporary staff from Poland and other beneficiaries of the European open market in labour.

The Grandee, Democrat and Lunity labels have maintained their share of the market despite increased competition on the high street. However the slump in sales of Planet Caucus last year raised the question of the future of this operation which was eventually resolved this month by a management buyout. Mr Roderick Bacon stepped down from the board on mutually agreeable terms and took with him his assistants, Mr Charles

Macdonald and Mr Lee Rock which was noted by Mrs Williamson, the company secretary, who wished them well in their future endeavours. But the board had been strengthened by the welcome return of Mr Kevin McHugh (NE sales) after an absence of ten years.

4TM, the brand launched in 2005 by Mr Jacob Wilde succeeded in retaining its market share in the youth market and its management has been strengthened with the appointment of Mr Robert Bryson as southern area manager.
