Deputy leader CHRIS BAUGH is rightly up in arms at revelations over the role of the secret police in preventing a top TROT from taking up the general secretaryship - despite winning the standard ballot in 1987.

Secret government files released earlier this year, under the 30-year rule, show that Margaret Thatcher's government directly meddled in the internal affairs of civil servants' union CPSA PBUT, the predecessor of the glorious Public and Commercial Services (PCS) union we know and love today.






