## NEC 2008 ELECTION ADDRESS ANALYSIS AND AWARDS

What can be more joyous for the keen PCS member than come April when the large white envelope with the NEC election material comes through the letter box and thuds on to the mat? It's time for our annual appraisal of the political players in what passes for a modern Trade Union.

### HEAVY CASUALTIES ON ALL SIDES

Before we go on to individual awards let's look at any general trends this year. If there was any doubt last year then this year it is crystal clear that the Grandees' still dominant ANTI-BARRY outfit, **Democracy Alliance** has become the PCS Establishment. Most of their candidates' election addresses are of the 'steady hand on the tiller', 'don't rock the boat' and 'vote for us because we do a good job now' type. GARY WINDER'S contribution perhaps sums this up best when he says:

*"This year you have a straight choice in this election. A Democracy NEC which has achieved much and has the experience and ability and track record to defend your terms and conditions or the alternative group who have no realistic, alternative policies, and are full on criticism but low on content. I suggest now is not the time to throw it all away and risk the negotiations we are in and progress we are making."*  
...which could be straight out of the election propaganda put out by any ruling politburo over the last century or two - including the poor grammar and sentence structure.

**4themembers** (who have at least managed to get all their candidates trading under the same brand this year) have put out two main messages:



Firstly, too much industrial action or *"No more strikes!- We've all had enough!"* as JAMES REYNOLDS puts it. As a campaign message in an election address this is something of a loser given that the few members who actually read the election addresses are those most likely to want to take strike action. Even the common herd are more militant this year, given the obvious gap between pay award and inflation rate. 4<sup>TM</sup> should reflect that more of their own followers take strike action than vote in the NEC elections!

#### Working Class Hero

The second message is that the only way the Democracy Alliance win is that not enough members vote. JAKE WILDE'S contribution encapsulates their position thus:

*"Last year only one in 10 members voted, allowing the extremists of Left Unity another year in charge. This current leadership are happy for turnout to be so low because that's the only way they are elected."*

Clearly the political nobrains in charge of 4<sup>TM</sup> have not really thought this through. Firstly, any decent political analyst will tell you that voters do not turn out to vote against the established political power when they believe there is no viable alternative. To advertise the fact in one's own election material that you have not been a viable alternative to the ruling political group does not encourage undecided members to vote for you. It hardly does much for your own supporters either.

Secondly, any member obsessive enough to wade through all the election addresses is almost certainly among the few motivated to vote. (Particularly if they're still awake by the time they get to JAKE'S contribution.) So it makes it look like you're more interested in appealing to those who don't participate (and don't read the election addresses) than your handful of loyal readers.

Thirdly it's bollocks. Presumably the 4<sup>TM</sup> NEC candidates imagine that their supporters in the derisory 15 odd Branches who nominated them are working flat out for their vote while the 130 or so Branches who nominated LEFT-UNITY FRONT (Democratic Alliance) candidates are doing sod all to turn out their vote because they know apathy will carry the day. But if the 130 odd Branches who nominated LUF candidates *were* to get off their arses to herd the sheep into the voting pens, they would be extremely unlikely to focus their efforts on potential 4<sup>TM</sup> fodder. Hence the turnout would go up but so would the LUF vote.

Obviously, one of the reasons for low turnout is that DEMALL Branches have become complacent. They're sure they are going to maintain a clear NEC majority with ease so why bother flogging themselves to death.



**The Independent Left** – the artists formerly known as SOCIALIST CARCASE - issued their revolutionary agenda headlining with ‘*We’re more left wing than the Democracy Alliance*’. Then waving their cojones in the air with a call for “*a national voluntary levy*”. That’ll have management quaking in their boots, or, more likely, ROFL. A number of their candidates are also going with the electrifying “*Enough is enough*” and “*Time for a Change*” slogans used by long time losers everywhere when they think hostility to the current regime is enough to win them a turn at the tiller.

### **BRIGHTON HURRICANE APPEAL**

A major hurricane (Hurricane Shazza) and an earthquake measuring 5.8 on the Richter scale hit the South Coast in the early hours of Sunday. Its epicentre was in Brighton. Victims were seen wandering around aimlessly, muttering "Faaackinell".

The hurricane devastated the area causing approximately £30 worth of damage. Several priceless collections of mementos from Majorca and the Costa del Sol were damaged beyond repair.

## News in Brief

### Drug dealers to receive tougher sentences

Drugs 'Tzar', Nicholas Romanov, has announced tougher new sentences for persistent offenders. "The provisional clarification of intentionality led us further to the difference in ontological constitution between the objective entity and subjective entity" and others will be phased in from early 2009.

### Government brands children 'immature'

The government yesterday ended speculation about their ongoing investigation into Britain's youth culture. Speaking on behalf of an interim council set up to study the behavioural patterns of children aged seven and under, spokesman Robin Lowell announced; "They know nothing about politics, finance or world affairs and want to play the whole time. They're just a bunch of fucking kids."

### Footballer-spit to be harvested to beat summer hosepipe ban.

Thames Water today unveiled a radical plan to harvest the spit of professional footballers in an attempt to avoid a hosepipe ban this summer. After a month long study of Premier League teams, it was found that on average, a player flobbered 10ml every couple of minutes. This gives a production rate of nearly 10 litres per game, not including extra time, or penalties.
